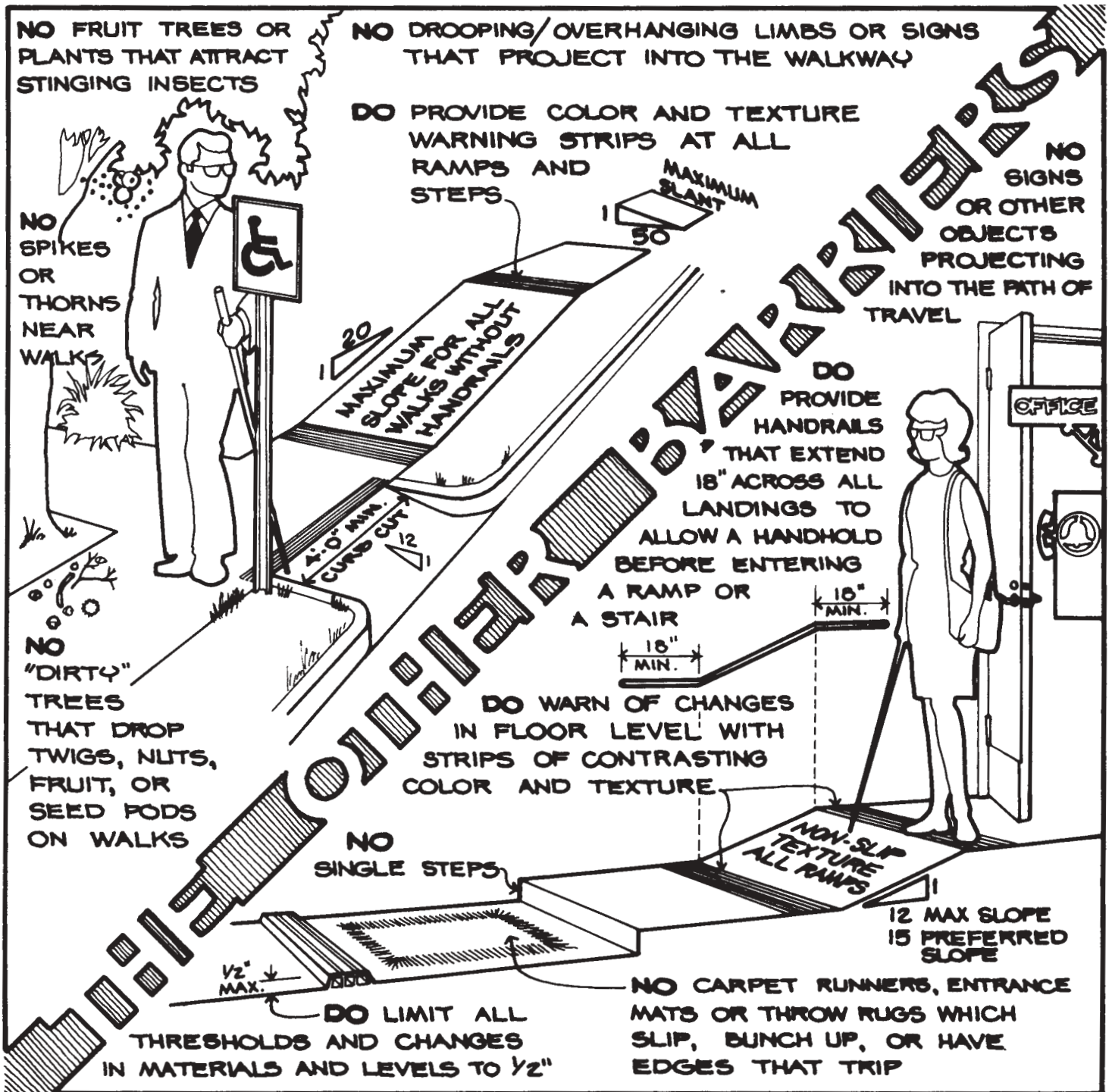

USE BRAILLE DOTS AND TACTILE LETTERS ON ALL CHURCH SIGNS

MOUNT ALL SIGNS AT ONE HEIGHT AND IN A UNIFORM LOCATION SUCH AS THE CENTER OF DOORS
 5'-0" ABOVE FLOOR
 4'-6" MIN. - 5'-6" MAX.

USE ONE INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL OF ACCESSIBILITY AT THE FRONT DOOR IF THE ENTIRE BUILDING IS BARRIER-FREE.

TACTILE LETTERS MAY BE EITHER RECESSED OR RAISED
 1/16"

NO SERIFS
 1/4" MIN.

USE SIMPLE BLOCK LETTERS
 5/8" MIN. - 2" MAX.
